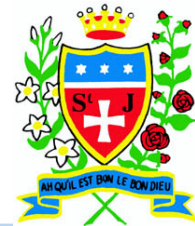


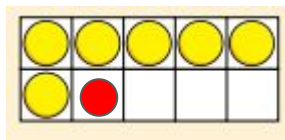
KIRF- I can name numbers in order to 10. I can say 1 more than a given number up to 10.

Abstract:

3 is 1 more than 2

$$2 + 1 = 3$$

9 is 1 more than 8

$$8 + 1 = 9$$

Can you make a number **1 more than 2**?

What number is **1 more than 3**?

What number comes **after 7**?

How many **are** there?

How many **are there now**? (after adding 1)

What is **1 more than** ?

What is the number **after** ?

Things to try:

Everyday Objects- Get groups of everyday objects and ask the children to count them. Can they put them in order? Can they add one more? How many now.

Guess my number: I am thinking of a number. It is one more than 5 what is my number?

Number recall games- write 6 numbers on a piece of paper. Say a number and if they have that number cross it off. Get a pack of cards with numbers up to 10. Turn a card and say that number as quickly as you can.

Counting: Use numbered finger puppets. Which number comes next?
