## Questions to ask at home

What do you notice?

How do you see it?

How many are there altogether?

How many different ways can you find (1,2,3,4,5)?

Where can you see (1,2,3,4,5)?

## Things to try:

**Everyday Objects-** Gather together up to 5 objects place them in different arrangements and ask children to say how many there are.

**Rearrange game-** Gather a set of objects (5 or less) and ask the children to arrange them in as many ways as possible.

**Number spot-** Say a number up to 5 and ask the children to spot that number of objects in their everyday environment.

**Dice roll-** play a game that involves a dice and ask the children to say the number of dots on the dice (Adult can say 6)
