Try to include the roads and some of the main features e.g. shops/a park/ bus stops. (You could ask a parent/carer to take you for a walk around the area before you start your map and you could make some notes about what to include.)</p> <p>(1 credit upon submission of your map)</p>	<p>Design your own Coat of Arms. <p>Choose a wild animal that can be found in the UK. Write a short report about it that includes some interesting facts.</p> <p>(1 credit upon submission of the report)</p>	<p>Chinese New Year began on 29th January. 2025 is the Year of the Snake. Draw a snake picture or write a snake poem to celebrate.</p> <p>(1 Credit upon submission of picture and/or poem)</p>	<p>Draw your own 'still life' picture of daffodils in a vase. You could use real daffodils or copy from an online picture. Colour or paint your picture.</p> <p>(1 credit when you show your picture to your teacher).</p>
